St. Irenæus, after listing Telesphorus as a martyr, adds the name of Hyginus (died 142). His name was placed in the Roman Missal in the late Middle Ages; during the first two centuries hardly any of the martyrs had left any trace in the Liturgy. Their burial places were generally unknown and their worship was local; there was danger that Catholic devotion to the saints might be regarded as a
