JUNE 14, ST. BASIL THE GREAT, DOCTOR OF THE CHURCH

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St. Basil the Great was Archbishop of Caesarea in the Asiatic Province of Cappadocia. His solid and eloquent words silenced the Arian heretics who were persecuting the Church, and he restored the spirit of discipline and fervor. He was one of the most celebrated Fathers of the Eastern Church. He is the author of a monastic rule from which St. Benedict derived many points, and which is still observed by the monks of the East. During his lifetime he was called a vessel of election by St. Ephrem. He died January 1, 379.
