St. Felix of Valois, of the royal family of France, was inspired with the desire of founding an Order for the redemption of Christian captives. He moved St. John of Matha, then a youth, to join him, and together they founded the Order of the Most Holy Trinity. After a life of great sanctity St. Felix died in 1213.
