

## JUNE 12, ST. JOHN OF SAN FACUNDO, CONFESSOR

St. John was born at St. Facundus in Spain, and belonged to the Augustinian Order. He was distinguished for his devotion during holy Mass; he loved peace-making and brought an end to a civil war among the factions in Salamanca. He died June 11, 1470.

Commemoration of Sts. Basilides, Cyrinus, Nabor, and Nazarius: These men were Christian soldiers in the army of Maxentius. They were beheaded by order of Aurelius, prefect of Rome.
