St. John, because of his divine love called "of God," founded the order of Brothers Hospitallers, which devotes itself to the healing of bodies and of souls. He is patron of Catholic hospitals and of all those whose last days of expiation upon earth, before appearing at the judgment seat of God, are passed amid the throes and agonies of disease. Leo XIII caused his name to be placed in the Litany of the Dying. The pharmacy of the apostolic palaces is always under the direction of a Religious of the Order of St. John of God, who thus holds the post of infirmarian to the Pope. He died March 8, 1550.
