## W/ COMMEMORATION OF 5TH WEDNESDAY OF LENT

This ancient feast, like that of Christmas, was considered originally as a feast of Our Lord, rather than of the Blessed Virgin. It has been fixed on the date of March 25, since before the Seventh Century.

At the High Mass on this day the celebrant and his ministers kneel on the altar steps during the singing of the Et incarnatus est, in the Nicene Creed.
