St. Alexander, Pope, was martyred, A.D. 119, in the tenth year of his pontificate. With him suffered Sts. Eventius and Theodulus. St. Juvenal (A.D. 367), also commemorated on this day, was a holy bishop in Central Italy.

the unity of the Holy Spirit, God, forever
and ever.

Blessed be the God and Father of our
Lord Jesus Christ, Who according to
His great mercy hath regenerated us
unto a lively hope, by the resurrection
of Jesus Christ from the dead, unto an
inheritance incorruptible, and undefiled,
and that cannot fade, reserved in
heaven for you, who, by the power of
God, are kept by faith unto salvation,
ready to be revealed in the last time.
Wherein you shall greatly rejoice if now
you must be for a little time made
sorrowful in divers temptations: that the
trial of your faith much more precious
than gold (which is tried by the fire)
may be found unto praise and glory
and honor, at the appearing of Jesus
Christ our Lord.

At that time, Jesus said to His disciples:
I am the vine, you the branches: he that
abideth in Me, and I in him, the same
beareth much fruit: for without Me you
can do nothing. If any one abide not in
Me, he shall be cast forth as a branch
and shall wither, and they shall gather
him up and cast him into the fire: and
he burneth. If you abide in Me and My
words abide in you, you shall ask
whatever you will, and it shall be done
unto you. In this is My Father glorified,
that you bring forth very much fruit and
become My disciples. As the Father
hath loved Me, I also have loved you.
Abide in My love. If you keep My
commandments, you shall abide in My
love: as I also have kept My Father's
commandments, and do abide in His
love. These things I have spoken to
you, that My joy may be in you, and
your joy may be filled.

Be glad in the Lord, and rejoice, ye just:
and glory, all ye right of heart, alleluia,
alleluia.

May a bountiful blessing, we beseech
Thee, O Lord, descend upon these
offerings and, through Thy mercy, may
it help to make us holy and to be joyful
on the feast of the saints. Through our
Lord Jesus Christ, Thy Son, Who lives
and reigns with Thee in the unity of the
Holy Spirit, God, forever and ever.

It is truly meet and just, right and for
our salvation, certainly at all times to
proclaim Thee, O Lord, but above all in
this time more gloriously, when Christ
our Pasch was sacrificed. For He is the
true Lamb Who hath taken away the
sins of the world: Who by dying hath
destroyed our death: and by rising
again hath restored us to life. And
therefore with Angels and Archangels,
with Thrones and Dominations, and
with all the hosts of the heavenly army,
we sing the hymn of Thy glory,
evermore saying:

Rejoice in the Lord, O ye just, alleluia:
praise becometh the upright, alleluia.

With our strength renewed from having
shared in Thy sacred gifts, we beseech
You, O Lord our God, that by the
intercession of Thy saints Alexander,
Eventius, Theodulus, and Juvenal we
may feel the effect of the worship we
are offering. Through our Lord Jesus
Christ, Thy Son, Who lives and reigns
with Thee in the unity of the Holy Spirit,
God, forever and ever.
